



Request for Multi-Student Discount

MCA financial aid is offered to families who have more than one child attending Mooresville Christian Academy, Covenant Christian High School, or Greenwood Christian Academy High School. MCA financial aid is also offered for families who have more than one child at MCA. Receiving the discount is based on the honor system. No income information is required to be submitted with this form.

Multi-Student Discount Guidelines:

Multi-child discounts are based on financial need and must be requested. The financial aid is a reduction in the tuition rate for your family, but it is not automatic. If 10% of your combined family income is less than you family's tuition, then you qualify for multi-child discounts. For example, if a family has a 4th grade and a 2nd grade student the tuition is \$9,106.00. If the family makes less than \$91,060.00, then they qualify for the second student discount. Please complete the Multi-child discount form.

1st student (oldest child of family enrolling) is in the highest-grade level and each additional student is in descending grade order. Pre-kindergarten (K4) ½ day and full day and ½ day kindergarten students are not considered in discounting of tuition.

Please complete the appropriate information below so the aid can be credited to your bill. No credits will be given until the request form has been returned to the billing office. Credits are not retroactive. See the tuition sheet for discount amounts.
