Statement of Cooperation

1. We have read the Student Handbook and will cooperate with the school to see that our child meets the standard of appearance and conduct as outlined therein. Furthermore, we grant the school the authority to discipline our child as necessary (as outlined in the Student Handbook), and agree to cooperate with discipline of our child at home as needed.
2. We will support the school and agree to bring any questions or criticisms regarding procedures or discipline directly to the administration or teacher involved (Matthew 18 Principle). We will not be a party to rumors. We will not spread discontent among our children, other parents, or community.
3. We have read the school's doctrinal statement, purpose, and objectives, and are willing to have our child trained in accordance with them.
4. We give permission for our child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school sponsored trips on or away from the school premises and absolve the school from any liability because of injury. In case of accident or serious illness, we 1) request the school to contact us, 2) authorize the school to call our physician if unable to reach us, or make any arrangements necessary if unable to reach us, or make any arrangements necessary if unable to contact our physician.
5. We agree to pay the tuition according to arrangements that shall be made, and understand that the monthly payment is due on the 1st day of the month, and any payment not made by the 15th of the month will result in a \$30.00 late fee being assessed. If our account becomes more than forty-five (45) days after the first, our child may be suspended temporarily from school unless a payment plan has been submitted to the Administrator. Also, if financial problems arise, we understand that the school will work with us in making special payment arrangements.
6. We understand that tuition and fee revenue may not sufficiently cover all the operating costs at MCA. We understand that MCA relies upon God's providence to bring the funds we need.
7. We agree to support the high academic standards of the school by providing a place at home for our child to study and by giving our child encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments. Note: For grades 6-8, homework can be checked online. Grades can also be checked on-line
8. We realize that a Christian school is not a substitute for the local church. Christian education is complete when the child receives instruction from the home, Christian school, and Bible-teaching church. We agree to pray for the ministry of the school, staff members, school board, and fellow families as we join in partnership with MCA in order to help us with our spiritual responsibility to our child.
9. We are aware that the infraction of any of these statements by our children or us could result in our child being suspended, which could lead to expulsion or you may be asked to withdraw your child.
10. We agree to pay ½ month's tuition (12 month payment plan) per child, if we do not notify the school by August 1, 2007, that we are not returning for the 2007-08 school year.
