



Statement of Cooperation/Parents Agreement 2010-2011

1. We give permission for our child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school sponsored trips on or away from the school premises and absolve MCA from liability to us or our child in the event of injury too our child at school or during any school activity, unless caused by the negligence of the school or any of its employees.
2. We agree to uphold the high academic standards of Mooresville Christian Academy by providing a place at home for our child to study and by giving our child encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.
3. We have read MCA's "Mission Statement", "Statement of Faith", and "Purpose and Objectives" (refer to current Parent and Student Handbook). We understand that these principles are the foundation of the entire MCA program, including all instruction and discipline. We shall endeavor to support and uphold the principles, practices and the educational policies of MCA in every way.
4. We will support the school and agree to bring any questions or criticisms regarding procedures or discipline directly to the administration or teacher involved (Matthew 18 Principle). We will not be a party to rumors. We will not spread discontent among our children, other parents, or community.
5. We realize that a Christian school is not a substitute for the spiritual training, fellowship and discipline of the home or local church.
6. We give permission for our child to be photographed for use on MCA promotional materials, website and yearbook.
7. We give permission for our names, home address & phone number to be listed in the MCA Family Directory.
8. We agree to make tuition payments to MCA in full annually, semi-annually or monthly. Any balance not paid by the agreed time will be charged a \$30.00 late fee unless otherwise agreed to by both parties in writing, and that any child whose account is more than 45 days overdue could be subject to dismissal. We also understand that neither report cards, transcripts, nor school records will be released until all financial obligations are met.
9. We understand that tuition and fee revenue is not sufficient to cover all the operating costs at MCA. We further understand and agree to commit to prayer and realize additional donations are needed to meet the operation budget of the school. We understand that MCA consciously and deliberately chooses to rely upon God's providence to bring these funds to us.
